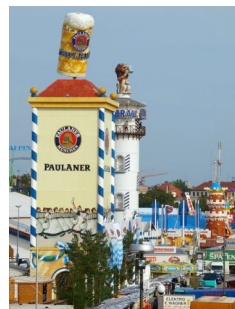
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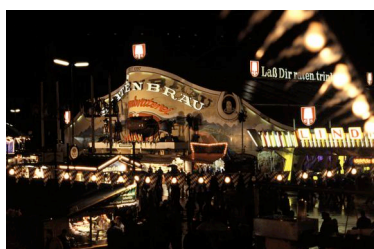


## About Oktoberfest:

*With the Hautes Vacances Group, you will stroll around the Wiesn for two days enjoying the fair and the beer tent celebrations. Hautes Vacances has reserved a table at the gay night in the Bauroesl tent (which is fully sold out already!) as well as a table in the Kaefer tent, where German and international celebrities celebrate Oktoberfest. But don't fall in love too early with beers and boys at the Oktoberfest as each night we also aim to explore Munich's nightlife as well...*



*Oktoberfest is a sixteen-day festival held each year in Munich during late September and running to early October. It is one of the most famous events in Germany and the world's largest fair, with some six million people attending every year. Oktoberfestbiers are the beers that have been served at the event in Munich since 1818, and are supplied by 6 breweries. Visitors also eat huge amounts of food, most of it traditional hearty fare such as Hendl (chicken), Schweinsbraten (roast pork), Haxn (knuckle of pork), Steckerlfisch (grilled fish on a stick), Würstel (sausages) along with Brezel (Pretzel), Knödeln (potato or bread dumplings), Käsespätzle (cheese noodles), Reiberdatschi (potato pancakes), Sauerkraut or Blaukraut (red cabbage) along with such Bavarian delicacies as Obatzda (a spiced cheese-butter concoction) and Weisswurst (white sausage).*

21 September 2009

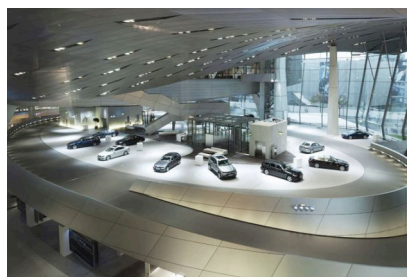
Munich

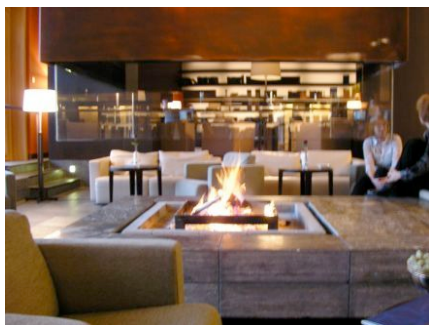
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23 – 24 September 2009
